Local San Diego artist, Jon Koehler, has been selected for his third consecutive Urban Tree. This new piece, 'Pinnacle', will grace San Diego's Embarcadero from April, 2006 through May, 2007. 'Pinnacle' will be a kinetic sculpture standing 17 feet tall and 10 feet wide. Koehler's newest project, 'Pinnacle', will be constructed of polished and painted stainless steel. The Unified Port of San Diego has chosen Jon Koehler's work for each of its Urban Trees projects, starting in 2003 with 'Evolution', a kinetic stainless steel sculpture representing three sails being powered by the wind's movement, and in 2005 with 'Waves of Time', a polished stainless steel kinetic sculpture that reflects images from its environment. 'Waves of Time' is currently on display at the San Diego Embarcadero and will be up until the latest Urban Trees are installed.

In addition to Jon Koehler's Urban Trees pieces, he has been commissioned by the City of Coronado to create a sculpture, 'Freedom', which will be installed at the Glorietta Bay Pocket Park within the next year.

Lifetime San Diegan, Jon Koehler, comes from a lineage of artistic craftsmanship, dating back to his father's ability to create wooden boats by hand. Jon Koehler has carried on the tradition through his metal fabrication and artistic talent.
